### **INDOOROOPILLY RIVERWALK PROJECT End of construction**

Brisbane City Council is pleased to announce that construction of the Indooroopilly Riverwalk is now complete. Construction of the riverwalk started in April 2020 and has been completed six months ahead of schedule.

The riverwalk significantly improves active transport through the area by providing a safe and accessible route from Twigg Street to the Jack Pesch Bridge and the Indooroopilly Rail Station, with additional connections to Radnor Street and Riverview Terrace. Additionally, residents and visitors will also have access to impressive views of the Brisbane River and the iconic Walter Taylor Bridge.

Key features of the Indooroopilly Riverwalk project include:

- Five-metre-wide pedestrian and two-way separated cyclist facility.
- Shared cyclist and pedestrian connection to Foxtan Street from the riverwalk.
- Upgrade of the Foxtan Street and Radnor Street intersection to create a safer environment for all road users.
- Connection to the Jack Pesch Bridge and Indooroopilly Rail Station by linking the Riverwalk to the existing path at Witton Barracks.
- A dedicated pedestrian connection to Riverview Terrace.
- Viewing platforms on the riverwalk overlooking the Brisbane River and the iconic Walter Taylor Bridge.
- Lighting along the length of the riverwalk.
- Landscaping and wayfinding signage.

Council would like to thank everyone for their patience and cooperation while these important works were carried out.

The Indooroopilly Riverwalk is a critical part of a future active transport corridor between the Western Freeway Bikeway and the University of Queensland.

We are continuing to invest in our cycling network to improve safety, connectivity and accessibility, encouraging everyone to enjoy our beautiful climate and explore our city by bike.
