## Cricket

9A, 9B, 8A, 7A, 7B and 7C travelled to Toowoomba on Saturday to play against teams from Downlands College, Scots College Warwick and TACAPS in the inaugural QCIS Cricket Cup. 9A were successful in a final ball thriller against Downlands 14A, 9B were outmuscled by TACAPS 14A, 8A were convincing winners by more than 100 runs over Downlands 13A, 7A maintained their unbeaten record for the season (must be the coach) despite a few jitters early in the run chase against Downlands 12A, 7B had enough runs on the board but couldn't hold Scots 14A and 7C just didn't have enough urgency early in their batting innings and were overpowered by TACAPS 12A. In a points system based on wins achieved, runs per wicket lost, wides bowled and catches taken, ATC ran second to TACAPS. Great day and great bus convoy!

The remaining ATC teams in Years 5-9 played against Nudgee College, St Laurence's College and Marist Brothers Ashgrove. Seven teams were successful whilst five finished second. 5A staged a remarkable turnaround, from 8/29 chasing 73 for victory, passing the SLC total without further loss and powering to 9/92. 6B chased down a huge SLC total of 4/122 from 25 overs passing the total in the final over with some fantastic running between the wickets a feature of the innings.

**Notable performances** were Cam Hunt (86\* runs for 8A against Downlands College), Luke Page (38\* runs for 8A against Downlands College), Will Ghush (28\* runs and 2/1 from 3 overs for 8A against Downlands College), Zeke Fimeri (2/7 and 3 catches for 8B against Nudgee College), Seb McCormack (22\* runs for 5A against SLC), Noah Clifford (20\* runs for 5A against SLC) and Daniel Milligan (20 runs for U10 Galway against Albany Creek Black).

Parents are reminded that all Year 4 and 5 teams, 6A, 6B, 6C and the Intermediate First X1 have matches on Saturday, 19 March 2016. 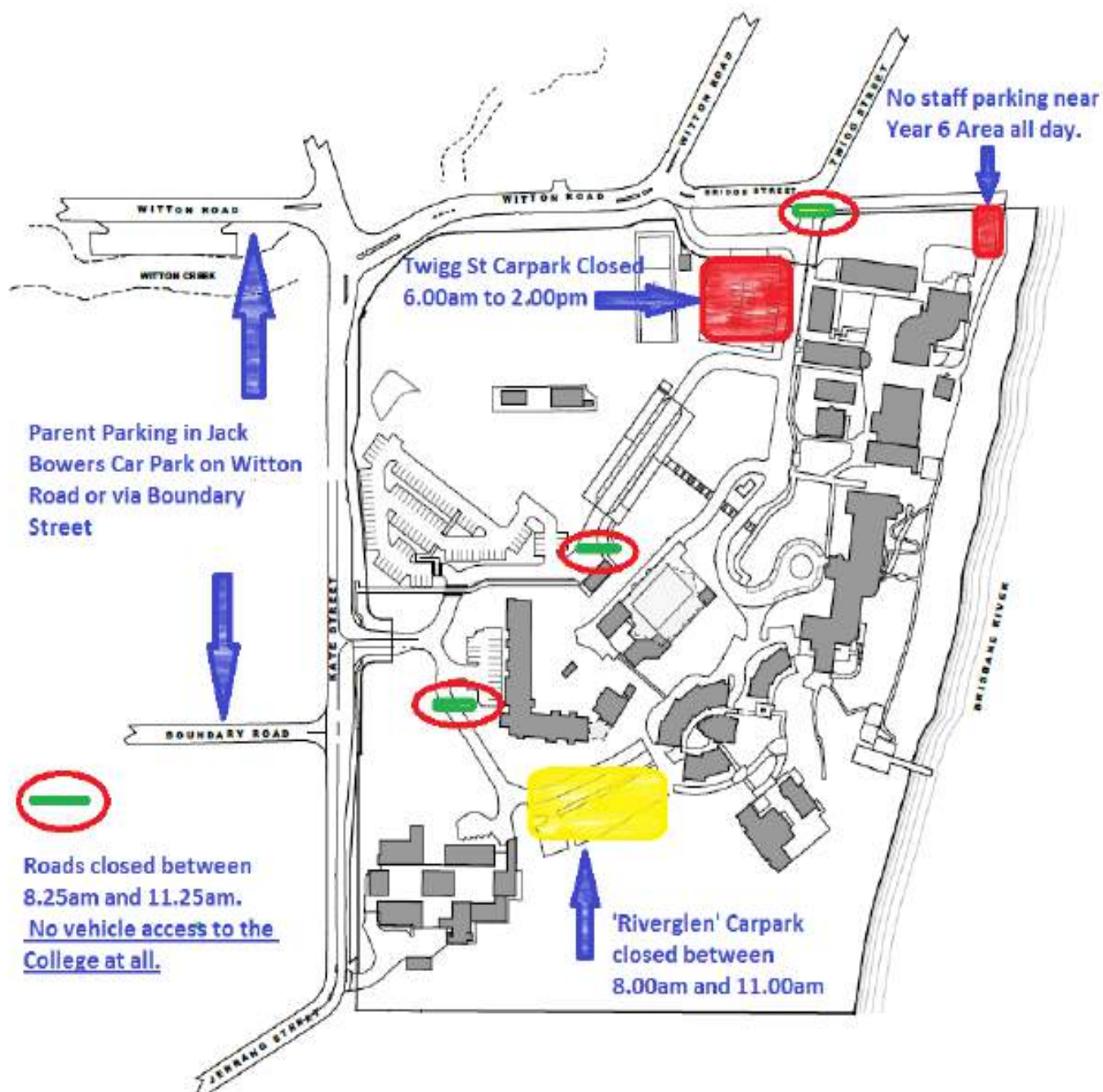
